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THE EDIBLE GARDEN

This hands-on course will give you the skills you need to set up and manage a productive garden throughout the seasons. It will cover the basics from sowing seeds to harvesting vegetables so that you can help children grow their own food.

- understand how plants grow from seed to crop
- learn how to prepare the soil to get the best yield
- learn what to plant and when to grow a range of vegetables throughout the year
- identify the parts of the plant that can be eaten

EXPLORIFY IN THE GARDEN



The RHS has teamed up with the Wellcome Trust to offer this subsidised course, which uses an innovative approach to learning science in your school garden.

You will learn how to take the primary science curriculum outdoors, making use of the opportunities that nature, plants and growing provide.

This course will help you to:

- work with Explorify resources developed by the Wellcome Trust
- improve your growing techniques and horticultural understanding
- realise how 'growing topics' can spark curiosity and inspire children to question the world around them
- discover new plants that can help you teach primary science in an exciting way, whilst having a positive impact on learning

- develop quick and easy-to-implement activities that link to the garden and work inside and outside
- create a diary of seasonal gardening activities, focussing on plants that are easy to grow
- improve your horticultural understanding and confidence in explaining basic gardening processes to young children

Primary Science

- The RHS has joined forces with the National STEM Learning Centre (NSLC) to create a two-day residential course. You will learn how to use plant science throughout Key Stages 1 and 2, through a variety of inspiring lesson ideas.

Secondary Science

- During this two-day residential course, you can expect to gain the practical skills and knowledge to support teaching and learning in secondary school science. This course is also run in conjunction with the National STEM Learning Centre, and focuses particularly on biology and environmental science.
